# The **PASET** Regional Scholarship and Innovation Fund



An Africa-led initiative to bridge the skills gap in Applied Sciences, Engineering, & Technology

The Regional Scholarship and Innovation Fund (RSIF) is one of the flagship programmes of the Partnership for Skills in Applied Sciences, Engineering and Technology (PASET), an initiative by African governments to address systemic gaps in skills and knowledge necessary for long term, sustained economic growth in sub-Saharan Africa (SSA). PASET was launched in 2013 by the governments of Senegal, Ethiopia and Rwanda. The governments of Burkina Faso, Ghana, Côte d'Ivoire, Kenya, Benin, and Mozambique have since joined the initiative, while several others have expressed commitment to enter the partnership.

With funding from African governments, the World Bank and the Korean government, RSIF supports PhD training, research and innovation in various African universities that are selected as centres of leadership in fields identified by PASET as priority economic sectors for growth and development, including energy, food security, ICT and materials science. The International Centre of Insect Physiology and Ecology (icipe - www.icipe.org) serves as the Regional Coordination Unit (RCU) of the Regional Scholarship and Innovation Fund (RSIF).

Reporting to the Communication officer, the Communication Intern will be an integral part of the team and will ensure effective, outcome-oriented communication both internally and externally.

The internship position is tenable in **Nairobi, Kenya**. It will be offered for an initial contract of three months, renewable for three more moths, subject to continued project needs, funding for the position, and performance of the staff member.
